1. The Tournament Committee

Director of the tournament: Angelika Eratowska

Head referee: Jolanta Makuch

Referee: Piotr Urbański

The Tournament Committee will issue local rules before the start of the first round of the tournament. The tournament is played in accordance with the "General Regulations of PGA Poland Tournaments" and with the Hard Card 2022.

The tournament takes place under the patronage of Polish Golf Union and is a ranking tournament of the Polish Golf Union.

Floating Garden Szczecin Open will be played on 21-22 of May at Binowo Park Golf Club.

2. Eligible to play

a. The limit of players in the tournament is set to 120 players. The order of applications decides, provided that the entry fee is paid within SEVEN DAYS BEFORE THE TOURNAMENT IS STARTED

b. Professionals: In accordance with paragraph 2 of the General Regulations of the PGA Poland Tournaments

c. Amateurs: Players with both active and inactive HCP will be allowed to play. Players who do not have active handicaps will not be included in the net classification. The maximum exact handicap of players: 30.0. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to distribute 10 "wild cards" to people with exact handicaps above 30.0, these players will be calculated from a Playing HCP of 30.0.

3. Applications and reserve list

a. Applications are accepted only by completing the registration form and paying for participation in the tournament by bank transfer to the account provided on the website www.pgapolska.com;

b. Deadline for applications and payments: SEVEN DAYS BEFORE THE TOURNAMENT STARTED; c. Individuals who apply after the deadline contained in the regulations will be given the opportunity to play after obtaining the permission of the Tournament Director.

4. Start the tournament

a. Starting time: from 8:00am

b. Persons who, despite making the payment, did not register for the start, will be deprived of the right to start in the next two tournaments organized by PGA Poland

c. On the first day, the starting groups will be selected on a random basis among professional players and PGA Polska members. Amateurs according to the growing HCP values, and during subsequent days according to the results of Gross Stroke Play.

5. Tournament format

Professionals: 36 holes in the Gross Stroke play format

Amateurs: 36 holes in the Gross Stroke Play format

Amateurs: 36 holes in Stroke play Netto format

6. Cut

After the second day of the tournament, the cut formula will be used. 72 players will go to the

third round, plus draws. All players who do not pass the cut will have the opportunity to play the round after the tournament.

7. Tee

a. women: yellow, field length 5441 m

b. men: white, field length 6013 m,

TEE AMATEURS:

a. Women and juniors under 12: yellow

b. men and juniors over 12 years of age: white

8. Fees

a. Professionals:

b. Amateurs:

i. Club members - PLN 270

ii. Club Juniors (up to 26 years) - PLN 190

c. Sponsors and wild cards - according to the decision of the Tournament Committee

9. Awards

I, II, III place among amateurs of Gross Stroke Play classification after 36 holes

I, II, III place among amateurs of net Stroke play classification after 36 holes

The best woman in the Stroke Play gross classification and stroke play net after 36 holes. The best junior (to 18 years) in the category Stroke play gross and stroke play net after 36 holes I, II, III place among the professionals of Stroke play classification after 36 holes The prizes in gross and net classifications are disjoint. Gross category is the main category and players receiving prizes for the gross category are not included in prizes in the net category. The distribution of the cash pool will be published on the website www.pgapolska.com.

The failure to collect the award on the prize giving ceremony by an amateur is tantamount to its loss. Prizes that will not be collected during the prize giving ceremony will be transferred to an additional competition during the final of the cycle - PGA Polska Championship.

Professionals are required to attend the award ceremony and sign the attendance list. Failure to sign the list will result in non-payment of the cash prize.

10. Information

All information about the tournament, such as the composition of the Tournament Committee,

start lists, announcements of the Tournament Committee will be posted on the bulletin board in the Tournament Center and on the website www.pgapolska.com

11. Draws

Pro: a. In the case of a tie for the first place in Pro in the classification of Gross Strokeplay, extra-time overtime will take place immediately after the main round. Overtime rings will be announced by the Tournament Committee before it begins.

b. In the case of draws in the second and subsequent places, the competitors will be classified ex-aequo. Amateur: In case of a tie for the first, second and third place among Amateurs in the classification of Gross and Gross Strokeplay, the rule of taking a higher place will be determined by the countback rule: better second round, 9, 6, 3, 1 second round. In the event of draws for non-awarded places, ex-aequo places will be awarded. The last 9 holes are understood as holes 10-18 of the field.

12. Ranking Points PZG

PZG ranking points will be awarded in accordance with the Polish Golf Union Ranking Regulations 2022.

13. Personal data

According to the Polish law art. 13 para. 1 and par. 2 GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation. Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (general regulation on data protection) of April 27, 2016 (Journal of Laws of EU, No. 119), we would like to inform you that:

1. The administrator of personal data of Tournament participants is the Association of Golf Instructors PGA Poland with headquarters in Warsaw 00-067, Al. Jerozolimskie 65/79, email biuro@pgapolska.com, contact telephone: 506875558
2. Personal data of the Athletes, such as: name, email address, telephone number, provided as part of the registration form will be processed by the Organizer to the extent necessary to conduct the Tournament, in particular in order to complete the application process and confirm the Player's participation in Tournament, announcement of results, distribution of prizes, consideration of possible complaints / claims made in connection with participation in the Tournament.
3. If the Athlete agrees, his personal data, in the areas referred to in point 1, shall also be processed by the Organizer in order to send the Athlete information and commercial information of the Organizer's partners.
4. Each participant of the Tournament agrees to take photographs, free use of the image in the film, photo and audiovisual materials prepared by the Tournament Committee or by an entity authorized by the Tournament Committee. Consent to the free use of the tournament participant's image includes multiple use of the tournament participant's image for promotional, marketing, advertising and publishing purposes.
5. The personal data of the Tournament participants will be used in accordance with the conditions set out in the GDPR Regulation, Polish regulations adopted in order to enable the application of the GDPR, other applicable laws and these Regulations.
6. The controller of personal data does not transmit data to a third country / international organization. Personal data of participants will not be subject to automated processing, including profiling.

7. The basis for the processing of personal data of the Tournament participants is art. 6 par. 1 letter b) GDPR - performance of the contract (acceptance of the Regulations and registration of participation in the Tournament constitutes the conclusion of the contract) and art. 6 par. 1 lit. a) GDPR - voluntary, unambiguous, informed and specific consent of the data subject.
8. Tournament participants have the right to access their data and the right to rectify, delete, limit the processing, the right to data transfer, the right to raise objections, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the legality of processing, which was made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing that was made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
9. Participants of the Tournament have the right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Body when the Participant considers that the processing of his personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
10. Providing personal data and consenting to their processing is voluntary, but their failure or lack of consent to their processing prevents participation in the Tournament. Making a notification is tantamount to accepting the rules contained in the Regulations of the event and giving consent to the processing of personal data. In the case of a minor, consent to the processing of personal data must be expressed by the person having parental authority or legal guardian.
11. The processing of data in connection with participation in the Tournament includes in particular:
- a. reminder about paying a fee for participation in the tournament by phone or email
 - b. the publication on the website of the Floating Garden Szczecin Open Tournament of the name and surname of the participant on the tournament start list along with the start times
 - c. the publication on the website of the Floating Garden Szczecin Open Tournament of the name and surname on the tournament score list
