### 1. Tournament Committee:

Tournament Director: Adam Mitukiewicz; Organising Director: Angelika Eratowska; . Main Rules Official: Jolanta Makuch

Tournament Committee shall publish the Local Rules before the commencement of the first tournament round.

The tournament shall be played according to the "General Conditions of PGA-Poland tournaments" and the Hard Card.

The tournament is organised under the patronage of the Polish Golf Union (PZG) and is a PZG ranking tournament.

The tournament will be hosted by Binowo Park Golf Club

### 2. Eligibility

1. The number of players in the field shall be limited to 120. The order of entries will depend on the date of entry and submission of the entry fee by **SEVEN DAYS BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE TOURNAMENT**,
2. Professionals: as per clause 2. of the General Conditions of PGA-Poland tournaments,
3. Amateurs: Players with an active as well as inactive HCP will be eligible to play. Players without an active HCP will not be classified in the net category. Maximum exact HCP shall be 30.0. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to distribute 10 "wild cards" to players with an exact HCP higher than 30.0.

### 3. Entries and reserve list

1. Entries can only be made through the official entry form and after payment of the entry fee to the bank account listed on [www.pgapolska.com](http://www.pgapolska.com),
2. The final deadline for entries and payment is **SEVEN DAYS BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE TOURNAMENT**,
3. Players who enter after the deadline described in the Tournament Conditions will need Tournament Director's approval to play.

#### **4. Starting times**

1. The tournament will start at 8:00.
2. Players who, despite paying the entry fee do not show on the starting tee will not be allowed to play in 3 subsequent tournaments organised by PGA-Poland.
3. On the first day, the starting groups will be selected on the basis of draws among professional players and trainees, amateurs according to increasing handicap values, and on consecutive days according to the results of Stroke Play Gross.

#### **5. Format of play**

Professionals: 36 holes – Stroke Play Gross

Amateurs: 36 holes – Stroke Play Gross

Amateurs: 36 holes – Stroke Play Nett

#### **6. Tees**

Professionals:

1. Ladies: yellow, course length 5441m,
2. Men: white, course length 6013m.

Amateurs:

1. Ladies and juniors under 12: yellow, course length 5441m, including changes in length allowed by the EGA,
2. Men and juniors over 12: white, course length 6013m, including changes in length allowed by the EGA.

#### **7. Entry fees**

Fees are accepted 7 days before the start of the tournament, ie before 15.04.2017, to the bank account given below. Payment after the deadline is subject to a fee increased by 50%. PGA Poland members with unpaid membership fee for the 2017 season will not be admitted to the tournament.

Professionals:

1. PGA-Poland Members – 150 PLN
2. PGA-Poland Applicants – 150 PLN
3. Professionals from outside PGA-Poland – 100 Euro

Amateurs:

1. Club Members – 180 PLN
2. Juniors – 160 PLN
3. Guests – 360 PLN
4. Sponsors' guests and wild cards: at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

## **8. Prizes**

1. Trophies for I, II, III place in the Professional 36-hole Gross Stroke Play classification,
2. Trophies for I, II, III place in the Amateur 36-hole Gross Stroke Play classification,
3. Trophies for I, II, III place in the Amateur 36-hole Net Stroke Play classification,
4. Best lady in the Amateur 36-hole Gross & Net Stroke Play classification,
5. Best junior in the Amateur 36-hole Gross & Net Stroke Play classification,

## **9. Information**

All information related to the tournament, such as members of the Tournament Committee, starting lists, communiqués will be posted on the official Notice Board at the Tournament Centre and on the website [www.pgapolska.com](http://www.pgapolska.com).

## **10. Ties**

Professionals:

1. In case of ties for the first place in Gross Stroke Play classification there will be a "sudden death" play-off immediately after the conclusion of the second round. The play-off holes will be announced by the Tournament Committee before the commencement of the play-off,
2. In case of ties for second and further places, the players will be classified ex-aequo.

Amateurs:

1. In case of ties for the first, second and third place in Gross & Net Stroke Play classification the following count-back method will be used: better final round, better last 9, if no conclusion – last 6, if no conclusion – last 3, if no conclusion - last hole of the final round,
2. In case of ties for further places, the players will be classified ex-aequo.

The last 9 holes for the purpose of the count-back are holes 10-18 of the course.

PZG Ranking points will be allotted according to the PZG 20167Ranking Regulations.

Prizes for the Gross & Net classifications are mutually exclusive. The Gross category is the main category, and players receiving prizes in Gross category will not be included in prizes for Net category.

Tournament Committee has a right to change tournament conditions.
